

2. Set a Social Story™ to a familiar children's tune or chant it to a rhythmic beat.



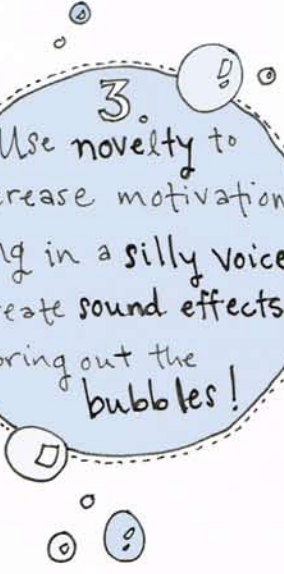
1. If your child can't fill in the last word to a song-phrase, give them a movement to imitate.

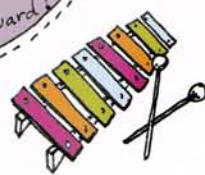
